

MEET DIRECTIONS

ROXBURY Roxbury swims at Horseshoe Lake at the Roxbury Twp. Municipal Complex on Eyland Ave. Take Rt. 10 east. About 1 mile east of the Ledgewood Triangle is Eyland Ave. Turn right onto Eyland Ave. Horseshoe Lake is about 1 mile on left side. This is also where the recycling center is located.

CRANBERRY LAKE Take Rt. 80 west to the Rt. 206 North exit. Stay on 206 about 3.75 miles. Parking is on either side of the Adam Todd Inn on the left (just before the traffic light at Tamarack Road).

FLANDERS SWIM CLUB Take Rt. 80 west to Rt. 206 South. Go about 1.5 miles to Drakedale Rd., Turn right. Go about $\frac{3}{4}$ miles to Flanders Rd., turn right. The swim club is on the left. This is a pool.

RANDOLPH PARK Take Rt. 10 east to Canfield Rd. Make a U turn at the stop light. Come back down the hill and you will see a sign for Randolph Park on your right (just past the strip mall at the bottom of the hill). Turn right and drive to the parking lot. The lake is on the left.

MENDHAM TWP. Take Rt. 10 east to the Sussex Turnpike. Take the Sussex Turnpike about 3.5 miles to Old Brookside Rd. Turn right on Old Brookside Rd. and follow to the end. Turn right on Woodland. About $\frac{1}{2}$ mile later you will see a reservoir on your right and start descending a steep hill. At the bottom of the hill take the left fork which is still Woodland Rd. About 1 mile later Woodland ends at Main St. in Brookside. Turn right onto Main St. In less than $\frac{1}{4}$ mile you will see a school sign on the left. Turn left into parking lot. Pond is on the right.

SHONGUM LAKE Take Rt. 10 east to Millbrook Ave. (about 5.6 miles east of Ledgewood Triangle). Turn right on Millbrook Ave. Fifth left is a 'Y', bear left onto Piedson's Hill Rd. At the end turn left onto Everdale Rd. and bear right onto Shongum Rd. Stay on Shongum Rd. until you see the lake on your right (at corner of Radtke). Turn right on Radtke and park on the left side of the road where the other cars are parked.

Alternative route: Rt 10 east to Sussex Turnpike. Take Sussex Turnpike about 4 miles to East Hanover Ave. Turn left on East Hanover, go about $\frac{1}{2}$ mile to Radtke, turn left, follow Radtke almost to the end and you will see the other cars parked.

LAKE FOREST Take Mt. Arlington Blvd. north through Mt. Arlington where it turns into Howard Blvd. Left on Howard Blvd and it turns into Espanong Rd. You will see a store named 'Chabons' on the right and then cross a small bridge. After the bridge make a left on Ripplewood and go to the end. Turn left at Yacht Club Dr. Park in the parking lot at the club.

LAKE SHAWNEE Take Mt. Arlington Blvd. North through Mt. Arlington where it turns into Howard Blvd. Left on Howard Blvd and it turns into Espanong Rd. Continue on Espanong Rd. until it crosses Rt. 15. Go over Rt. 15 and go past the turnoff for Rt. 15 north. Take the first right and go downhill to the end of this road. Turn right on West Shawnee Trail. You will see parking on your left at the bottom of the hill.

SHORE HILLS Take Rt. 80 to exit 28. From the east, follow the road to the traffic light at the bottom of the lake. Turn right onto Mt. Arlington Blvd. Shore Hills is about $\frac{3}{4}$ mile on the left. From the west, go to the 'U' turn (jughandle) light on Rt. 46, make a U turn and follow the road signs to Landing/ Lake Hopatcong. This will bring you to a traffic light at the bottom of the lake. Go right on Mt. Arlington Blvd.

PARK LAKE Route 80 East to exit 37. Turn right at end of ramp toward Rt. 513 South. At first traffic light, bear soft right onto Hoagland Ave. Beach is at end of Hoagland, straight ahead.

DENVILLE Route 80 east or west to the Denville exit. Follow Rt. 46 east to Rt. 53 north. Follow Rt. 53 north into the center of town. At the five way stop proceed through the light to Diamond Springs road. Continue on Diamond Springs road until you see the Valley View School on your right. The second left after the school is Entrance road, there is a small sign for Cooks Pond on the road sign. Follow Entrance road until you see the pond on your right.
